The U.S. Army has ambitious plans for fiscal year 2023 and beyond. Guided by Secretary Christine Wormuth's six operational imperatives – see and sense farther, mass dispersed forces with combat fist, win the fires fight, protect forces from air, missile and drone threats, communicate and share data rapidly and sustain the fight across long distances – the Army is advancing its efforts to field 24 new systems by the end of this year and 35 by 2030.

CONTRACT OPPORTUNITIES



The **Army Contracting Command** plans to release a solicitation for the Warfighter Training Readiness Solutions contract in September 2023. The contract will cover the maintenance of training aids, devices and simulators worldwide and has an anticipated value of **\$5 billion**.



The **Army Materiel Command** will host an information briefing regarding two follow-on contracts for the Design, Development, Demonstration and Integration II vehicle. These follow-on contracts will support the research and development needs of the U.S. Army Space and Missile and Space Command and several additional federal agencies. D3I2 D1 is expected to be valued at **\$1.9 - \$2.5 billion**, and D3I2 D2 has an anticipated value of **\$1.5 billion - \$2.05 billion**.



The **Savannah District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** is currently accepting proposals for a **\$240 million** Multiple Award Task Order Contract to provide general design services for federal projects within the jurisdiction of the Savannah District.
